

Enduroplank™ in brown – what you need to know

Our sales team are pleased to advise that we have introduced Brown Enduroplank™ to our range.

Over the years we've been manufacturing Enduroplank™ customers have accepted that it comes in various shades of grey due to the variable base of recycled material used. This variance may be greater in the manufacture of brown products.

This is due to the fact that our products are manufactured from a wide range of recyclable materials. These materials come in a variety of colours and produce a base colour derived from the combination sourced. We add consistent pigments (master batch) to the recycled-plastic mixture, but the eventual shade depends on the base blend of colours.

This is why we require you to acknowledge the following points before we accept your order:

- Enduroplank™ in brown has more colour variation from batch to batch, or even throughout the same batch, than grey Enduroplank™. In the event of customer dissatisfaction due to this colour variance, The Enduroplank™ in brown may not be returned.
- Minimum order quantities apply and your order for Enduroplank™ in brown may be delayed until Replas has sufficient orders to justify a production run.

e.g. A single metre of Enduroplank™ weighs 5.8kg. If a customer required 2m lengths (11.6kg), then 215 lengths or more would have to be purchased. This is calculated by 2500kg's divided by 11.6kg.
