Retaining Panels Solve The Problem



Cairns City Council has used the Replas Retainer panels to replace broken and mould infested concrete blocks. The panels have been put in place using the pins into the existing concrete, which allows a very strong support for the panels. This drain will flood from time to time in periods of heavy rain and the panels have been put in place to withstand these events. This is also a consistently wet area and had a problem of the tree roots breaking out the concrete blocks. The construction workers have also commented favourably as to the ease of installation of the panels, which saves time in costs to the project and also the quality and look of the panels once in place.

Daintree National Park - Cape Tribulation
