

Installation

Terms and conditions

1. All quotations are valid for strictly 30 days only, with no exceptions.
2. Replas cannot accept Holding orders.
3. Replas will not store customer orders for longer than three weeks. If this time frame lapses, costs will be incurred at the customer's expense.
4. Quotations containing installation prices are subject to the following conditions:
 - A. Site must be:
 - i. Level and flat; significant additional excavation and/or retaining will be charged as a variation.
 - ii. Firm and dry to allow for suitable access for construction vehicles including cranes and concrete trucks;
 - iii. Concrete pumping or crane placement lacking proximity due to poor conditions will be charged as a variation;
 - iv. No allowance is made to widen access paths/roads or remove flora or fauna that inhibits access to site, nor are any repairs anticipated to have to be made to footpaths, crossovers or any other established surface.
 - B. All relevant underground services must be proved by a qualified tradesperson prior to firming up prices for connecting to existing services as actual depths and falls required may not be suitable. This will not be done prior to the receipt of an order however a reasonable estimate can be made. Dial Before You Dig enquiries will be made upon receipt of an order.
 - C. No allowance has been made to connect into existing services that are more than 10 metres from the boardwalk footprint.
 - D. No additional costs incurred as a direct result of the inaccuracy of or failure to perform a soil report will be charged as a variation. No allowance has been made by Replas to perform such a report.
 - E. There is no allowance for excavation of rock or blasting.
 - F. There is no allowance for reinstating turf around concrete slabs, unless stated otherwise.
 - G. Both in-situ and driven composite piling are costed on the basis that ground conditions are suitable in lieu of a geotechnical report or test boring. Engineering regarding bearing capacity for driven piles must be established in order to supply a firm price.
 - H. No allowance has been made for the provision of permits or inspections unless stated otherwise.
 - I. We reserve the right to alter our price if the initial quotation is based on a preliminary drawing in order to supply a budget estimate.
 - J. No allowance will be made for significant traffic control without the preparation of a traffic management plan by a professional Traffic Management Company.
 - K. Changing site condition such as rising and falling water levels and obstructions below water level such as debris and silt will form the basis for a variation where additional costs are incurred in the completion of a project.



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- L. Manual launching of barges via tilt truck have been allowed for and additional costs to crane equipment into any waterway will be charged as a variation unless otherwise stated.
- M. No survey of the intended construction zone has been made. Additional costs incurred in order to provide one, or as a result of alterations to preliminary drawings/design necessitated through the performance of one will be charged as a variation.
- N. The provision of toilet facilities, temporary fencing, site sheds and/or containers is made for a maximum period of one month only. Periods of hire incurred in excess of one month due to delays caused by the customer will be charged as a variation.
- O. Every effort has been made to protect finished concrete for a period of one hour after laying, including both barricading and supervision. Additional supervision requested beyond this will be charged as a variation.
- P. Allowance has been made for reinforced 100mm thick slabs. Additional concrete required for edge beams, additional thickness, colour etc. following results of a soil report or a specific request will be charged as a variation.
- Q. Color of the enduroplank™ may vary from initial sample received.
- R. No allowance has been made to excavate or dispose of any contaminated earth.
5. All customer purchase orders submitted to Replas should reference a current Quote Number. Acceptance of any quotation must be confirmed by way of fax, email or letter.
6. All colours (where applicable) should be stated on your purchase order. Replas will not be responsible for delays where colours elections are not forthcoming.
7. Any deliveries carried out where a product is not delivered or accepted (for whatever reason) and need to be re-delivered, will incur additional costs at a rate specified by the transport company. All extra costs relating to freight and storage will be provided at the customers' expense.
8. A fee proposal will be supplied to cover Drafting/Engineering costs to the degree determined mutually between Replas and our client. Please ensure you are aware of what level you have requested (Preliminary, Engineered, Workshop Drawings etc.).
