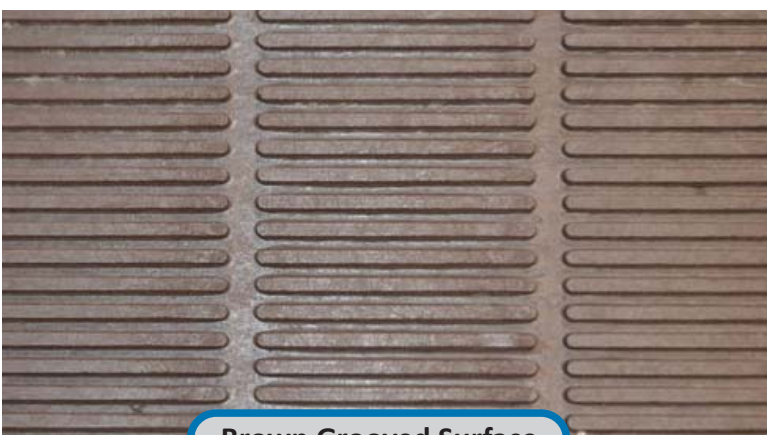


# Enduroplank™



Enduroplank™ is a recycled-plastic decking which represents the very latest technology. This hardwearing material not only offers you a sturdy, long-lasting and maintenance-free product, but also provides an ethical alternative to using timber.

Ideal for a myriad of commercial applications, Enduroplank™ is especially suitable for marine environments as salt water will not corrode the material, even when submerged. It will not split, rot, crack or ever need painting and will outlast timber decking by many years.

Grey Grooved Surface

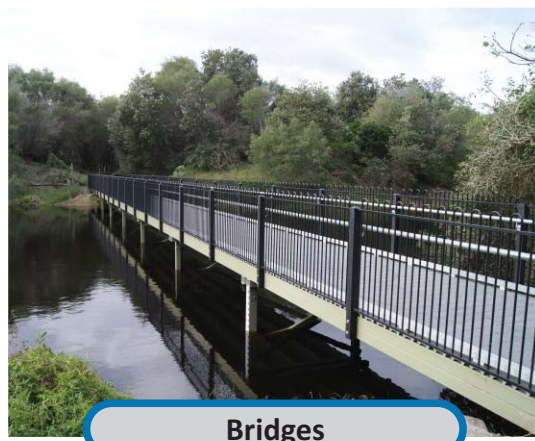

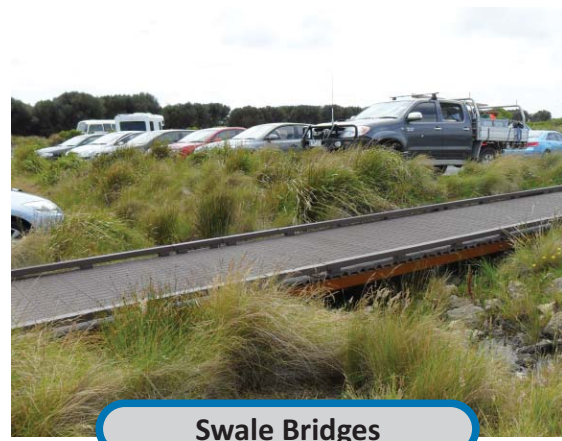

**Installation:** Enduroplank™ is easy to install due to the consistency and uniformity of the product. It can be installed in much the same way as timber, using similar equipment. Securing the planks to your supporting structure is very easy, we suggest pre-drilling and counter sinking. It is not recommended that Enduroplank™ be laid longitudinally, due to expansion and contraction issues.

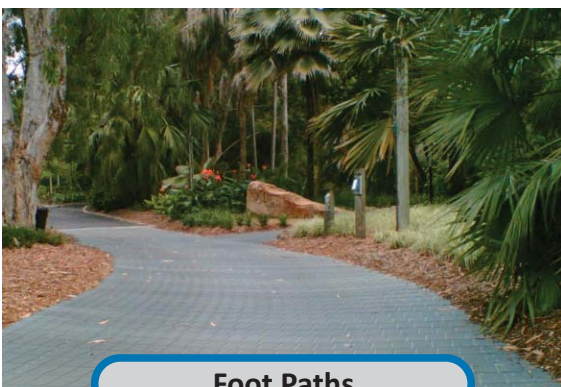
**Colour:** Grey and brown.

**Span Information:** We recommend a distance of 600 mm between supports. This will ensure there is minimal deflection, further increasing the life of your Enduroplank™. The recommended gap between planks is 5 mm.

**Jetty Capping:** (usually 90 mm x 65 mm), can be added to the sides of your jetty or boardwalk to provide a neat and attractive finish.

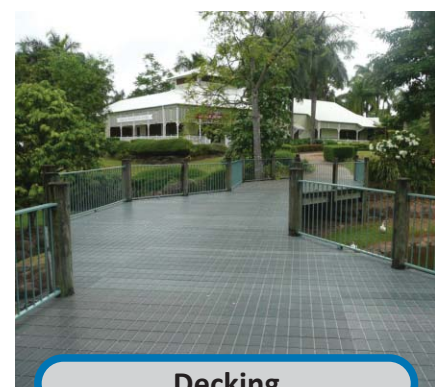
